Do fish get cold?

Yes, fish are very sensitive to changes in water temperature. So much so, in fact, that even a few degrees difference can sometimes kill them. Fish definitely get cold, the question is what "cold" means to them.

- All fish species have a preferred range of water temperature. However, it varies massively depending on where they're from. A tropical Lionfish might start shivering at around 75°, while a Northern Pike would get heatstroke in water that hot. Both these guys are incredibly hardy, they're just built for different conditions.
- The thing to remember about fish is that they're (mostly) cold-blooded. They don't have any way of warming themselves up. And on top of that, heat transfers much more quickly in water than in air. However, fish have developed a few tricks to make it through those long winter nights.
- Migrate by traveling until they find warmer waters
- Hibernate (or torpor) which is a very deep
- sleep, slowing their bodies and some even bury themselves in mud to keep warm.
- **Innovate** some fish have adapted to very
- cold waters; while others are actually able to warm their blood.

Prepare for the Holidays by Lisa Luck



The end of the year is rapidly approaching. This is the time of year when shopping increases – and so does the amount of trash we discard. As we prepare for the upcoming holiday season, rather than making a list of items to purchase, how about making a list of items that should not be purchased? This will reduce the amount of money we spend and also reduce the amount of harm done to the environment.

Serving a meal for family and friends? Avoiding plastics will be an easy way to decrease the amount of waste generated over a meal. Start with the table. A cloth tablecloth can be washed and reused rather than a plastic one that will be thrown away after one use. Use your regular plates, glasses, cups and flatware instead of buying flimsy plastic substitutes that don't hold up even for that one meal. Rinse the dishes after the meal and let them rest in the sink until you are ready to wash them. They won't go anywhere. This will keep a lot of plastic waste out of the landfill – and out of your body. Avoid serving beverages in plastic bottles as they pollute the earth.

Buying holiday decorations? A really fun project is to ask the children or artists in a family to share their artful expertise. This will bring items of interest to the table that can be shared and distributed after the event. Natural materials such as dried flowers, colorful leaves, ivy or fresh greenery can decorate the table instead of using plastic figurines and fake plastic flowers.

Considering buying a new outfit to wear? Consider using one that you already have. Fast fashion is increasing the emissions that are accumulating in the atmosphere and warming the planet. Many of the new clothes are made with plastic fibers that slough off as microfibers when they are washed or dried. These enter our water systems and water treatment filters cannot detect them. Water with microfibers are returned to our water source. The dryer propels plastic particles into the air and we breathe them into our lungs or ingest them as particles settle on food in the garden.

Plan to clean your house for company? Instead of conventional cleaners, use homemade cleaners such as vinegar, baking soda and castile soap. Cleaners with a warning on the bottle contain materials that can be harmful if inhaled. Inside pollution is frequently worse than outdoor pollution after a home has been cleaned with these toxic cleaners. Some guests are allergic to strong cleaners and may have allergic reactions to the smells.

What's for dinner? Buy food locally whenever possible to reduce the carbon footprint from your purchases. Buy fresh poultry or other meats locally at the Farmer's Market or natural food stores to avoid supporting meat raising farms where animals are frequently kept in captivity and overcrowded. Fresh is best!

Consider sharing an event as a gift rather than buying a thing. Less is more. Enjoy the holiday season!





This is why I recommend artificial Christmas trees to those with particularly curious pets that like to chew on plants. When decorating your tree, it's best to avoid tinsel and breakable ornaments to prevent potential hazards, and you should always secure your tree to prevent a climbing cat from tipping it over.
