Pointers For Parents

Screen Time Is Here To Stay!

(NAPS)—Halle Stanford, President of Television at The Jim Henson Company and mother to two boys, ages 19 and 6, shares her views on navigating the kids' TV landscape.

As a producer at The Jim Henson Company and a mom to two boys, I have a unique perspective on screen time. I've also explored this issue in one of my shows, *Dot.* This animated preschool series created by the fabulous Randi Zuckerberg addresses how technology can enhance a kid's everyday adventures. We were lucky to be advised by Yalda Uhls (author of *Media Moms and Digital Dads*) on creating a show curriculum that encourages kids and their families to be excellent digital citizens, to come up with a family media agreement, and to talk openly about screen time.

My personal philosophy on this issue is simple: Viva la screen time! I encourage my kids to enjoy movies, television, videos, apps, and more. Like my hero Jim Henson, I believe in the positive transformative power of media. As a producer, my goal has always been to create television and films that enrich, educate, and entertain. So I have always encouraged my boys to love the shows and games that they are drawn to, but also to discover programming that informs them on issues and ideas they are curious about. Favorites in our house range from Phineas and Ferb, Sarah and Duck, Reading Rainbow Skybrary, Despicable Me, Star Wars to Westworld, Nathan For You, Game Of Thrones, and The Walking Dead. (Remember, my boys are 13 years apart!)

As a momma, how much screen time do I let my youngest have? It has changed with his age and often depends on what's happening that day. In the summer, he's allowed screen time in the morning AND in the afternoon, but it's more limited during the school year. True confession: I don't have a set amount of time he always gets, but it's usually no longer than an hour. And we do talk about how long he'll be watching the shows before he settles in to viewing. And when that last show starts, he gets a

reminder that his screen time is almost up. Yes, there have been times when he grabs the phone or remote when screen time is over and runs around the house laughing, but I'm as quick as a cheetah.

My 19-year-old is an adult and at this point in his life, I trust him to regulate his own screen time. And still, the best I can do for both my boys is to model good screen time habits myself. When we are together, I do my best to use my phone only to snap those memorable photos or answer an urgent message. And I tell them why I am taking the time to focus on my screen and not on them. I also never answer the phone during meals or playtime. But, once they're asleep or out and about, I love having my own time to turn on my latest favorite show (hello, *Outlander!*).

We are in a new golden age of television and I would embolden parents to find shows that will delight and inspire their kids. It will take time (because there is so much content out there), but get involved with customizing your family's viewing experiences together—it's FUN! (And, if it happens to be Dot., Splash and Bubbles, Dinosaur Train, Doozers, Word Party, or Julie's Greenroom...even better!).



Tips on Grazing Management

Regular mowing is great for pastures. Immature, leafy grass plants are high in nutritive value (energy, protein) while mature, stemmy grass plants with seed heads have lower nutrition but higher fiber. Regular mowing encourages the plant to replace leaves



instead of going to seed. It also helps control some weeds! If using a rotational grazing system, a great time to mow is right after you switch horses to a new paddock. Never mow below 3-4 inches; this damages tall grasses and increases forage recovery time.

Once horses are acclimated to spring grass, it's time to start your grazing rotation. Start grazing a pasture when grasses have reached 8-10 inches, and move horses when grasses are 4-5 inches tall. If this takes longer than a week, you could add horses to the group or use temporary fencing to make the paddock smaller. Grass regrowth will be rapid in the spring (2 to 3 weeks), so as long as you have enough paddocks in the rotation, you shouldn't need to confine horses to stress lots unless it is raining and soggy.

Energy at rest or in motion?


The meaning of life....a more profound statement could never be asked. Why are we here? Is there more to our lives than just the physical experience in this body?

Compost Reports Needed by Lisa Luck



Did you compost in 2023? If so, it is time to report how much organic waste you composted in your yard. Materials that can be reported are grass clippings, leaves, manure, twigs or branches and food waste. As long as these materials stayed in your yard to decompose rather than being transported to the solid waste department or city brush collection sites - they can be counted. It doesn't have to be exact - estimates count.

So, why count the organic waste? The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) requires that every county show that at least 25% of the waste generated in that county was diverted from a Class I Landfill. A Class I Landfill accepts household waste including organic waste. Diversion is the statewide method used to help landfills last longer to provide ongoing waste disposal options for our county and others. Your report helps the county achieve this required 25% diversion rate.

All solid waste tonnages counted by the county and municipalities in Tennessee are reported to TDEC in an Annual Progress Report (APR). This report must be completed and submitted by March 31 each year. The APR is a report about all the trash, a.k.a. solid waste, generated in a county. Statistics compiled include number of tons collected, where the solid waste is taken for disposal and the cost of managing the waste. Solid waste is tracked in terms of weight of materials that are recycled, composted, or disposed in a Class I Landfill (household garbage) or Class III/IV (construction debris). These statistics become part of a larger report by Tennessee to be compared to other states, and become a part of a national report.

The county tracks as much of the solid waste that is generated as they have access to. Exceptions include organic waste that is composted by businesses or individuals. Another exception are recyclable materials that businesses recycle through other avenues rather than through the county. Composting totals or materials recycled elsewhere by a business can also be reported to help the county reach the 25% diversion rate.

Rather than putting food waste in with the household trash, compost it in your yard instead. Bagged yard waste materials can remain in the yard instead of taking it to a landfill or setting it curbside for city pickup. Materials that can be composted (and counted in this report) include glass clippings, leaves, twigs, branches, manure and food waste. To learn how to compost, go to www.whywastegarbage.com.

It is important to compost food or other organic waste in one's yard rather than discarding it in the trash. Organic waste releases methane gas as it decomposes in a landfill which contributes to excessive warming of the earth's atmosphere. Composting helps food waste decompose naturally into rich soil that can be used in the garden. If you composted food or yard waste at your home, email your report for 2023 to whywastegarbage2@gmail.com or text 931/261-7841. Tip: one gallon of food waste weighs approximately 8.5 pounds. Your report counts!
