Research Scientists Discover New Element

A major research institution has recently announced the discovery of the heaviest element yet known to science. The new element has been named Governmentium. How To Reduce Food Waste At Home

(NAPS)—Here's a cool idea: A clean, well-organized refrigerator can help your family prevent food waste.

Three Ways To Fight Food Waste

1. Know and, if necessary, reorganize your fridge and pantry. Keep your refrigerator and pantry clean and organized so you can see what needs to be eaten first. If fresh food is "out of sight, out of mind," it may be forgotten until it's no longer fresh and so ultimately wasted. Food is less likely to go bad when you use the more perishable and older items first.

Also, storing food in clear containers can help you see what you have available in your fridge and pantry and can help you avoid buying food you already have.

In the fridge, extend the life of your food by putting it in the right place. For example, the temperature in the refrigerator door fluctuates more than the cabinets or the back of the unit so don't store such perishable foods as milk in the door.

2. Download the FoodKeeper App. The USDA, the Food Marketing Institute, and Cornell University jointly created FoodKeeper, which is available free at the Google Play or iTunes stores, or via desktop at www.usda.gov/foodlossandwaste.

FoodKeeper provides guidance on safe handling, preparation, and storage of more than 650 foods and beverages. With the app, you can track storage times for different foods, see cooking tips, watch helpful videos, and get information on food recalls. Users can also set up calendar reminders for when products are nearing their recommended storage date.

3. Love your leftovers. Give leftovers a makeover when you reuse them in rec-

ipes. Add broccoli stems to a salad or omelet or blend overripe fruit and peels into a low-fat smoothie. My favorite all-time smoothie was made from about-to-expire chocolate yogurt and wilting blueberries and raspberries. Make broth from vegetable and/or meat trimmings, and freeze what you don't plan to eat right away.

Be creative while keeping leftover safety in mind. If you cook often and typically have loads of leftovers, consider having one dinner a week designated as Leftover Night.

Many foods can also be safely frozen indefinitely, so if you can't use something perishable before it may spoil, pop it in the freezer. Check the FoodKeeper app to see if your item may be frozen.

Mindfulness about food and food waste prevention in general can also help save you time and money. USDA estimates that each year at the consumer level, around \$1,500 of food goes uneaten per family of four. Imagine what your family could do with that kind of money.







Warm and Wonderful Pastrami-Spiced Veal Burgers

Place the breadcrumbs, milk, and salt in a bowl and soak the breadcrumbs until softened. Mix the veal with the breadcrumb mixture and combine to form six patties. Toast the peppercorns, coriander, and mustard seeds in a dry pan. Let cool and grind them with the paprika, onion powder, garlic powder, and brown sugar. Coat the burgers with the spice mixture. Heat a grill on medium-high heat. Grill the burgers to desired doneness but at least 71°C (160°F) for food safety, adding a slice or two of cheese to each burger towards the end, to slightly melt. Spread the bottom of the bun with the mayonnaise, and top with whole grain mustard. Place the burger on the bottom, top with sauerkraut, and top with the bun.

Great American Cleanup by Lisa Luck



Keep America Beautiful's (KAB) Great American Cleanup kicks off March 19, the first day of spring and continues through June 20, 2024, the first day of summer. According to their website, "The Great American Cleanup, the nation's largest community improvement program, creates positive change and lasting impact in local communities." This activity encourages residents to get involved and help clean up litter that has accumulated over winter months. February and March are particularly unsightly, as the weather frequently prevents regularly scheduled cleanups from happening.

Keep Tennessee Beautiful's (KTnB) Great American Cleanup kicked off March 1 and also continues through June 20, 2022. Their mission is, "Educating and inspiring Tennesseeans to take action every day to improve and beautify their community environment." Although registration for this event is not necessary to participate, your online registration will help KTnB track the number of volunteers that participate and the number of pounds of litter that are collected. Tennessee is one of the most beautiful states in the U.S. Unfortunately, the beauty is marred by litter. Litter can be seen along every road and waterway.

The Great American Cleanup event is not just limited to cleaning litter. Other projects beautify communities through planting flowers and trees, removing graffiti, improving dilapidated buildings and engaging community participation. Jennifer Lawson, President and CEO of KAB, stated, "With over 300,000 dedicated volunteers actively participating in 2023 – removing 10,714,210 pounds of litter, cleaning 1,947 miles of waterways, and planting 6,257 trees – the impact is evident." This event is financially supported locally by a Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) Litter Grant that is provided to Tennessee counties to fund litter cleanups.

Tennessee spends over \$23 million each year to clean up litter. The U.S. spends over \$11.5 billion. Yet, our communities continue to spill over with trash. Many people who litter do so because they have seen parents or friends discard trash in this manner. Others who litter will do so because they do not want to wait until a trash can is available. Others who litter are, "... making sure they are giving someone a job." This excuse is lame because most people who clean up litter are unpaid volunteers, including county inmates. There are not enough litter crews across Tennessee or the U.S. to keep up with all the litter that can be found in our communities.

Seventy percent of all litter is unintentional. Thirty percent is intentional -- discarded improperly on purpose. The most intentionally littered items are cigarette butts. Other littered items include beverage containers and packaging from food. Unintentional litter includes broken car parts, tires and trash that blows out of or off of vehicles. Litter discourages tourism and decreases the revenue from tourism that is used to improve our communities. Litter contributes to a drop in property values. The more litter you see – the more litter you will see. Call a friend, take a walk and pick up litter! The time you spend volunteering in your community immensely improves life for all of us.



Returning to earth after several orbital circles in outer space, a Russian cosmonaut proudly boasted, "I looked everywhere, but I didn't see God." That statement made me wonder what evidence would have been acceptable to him to prove that there is a God. 


