"This is going to hurt me more than it does you," said the father to his young son as he took him from the family room for interrupting our conversation. I'd heard that statement many times and always wondered what the parent wanted the child to understand when it was used. If it was used to redirect a child's behavior and teach him or her an important lesson about life, why not say so. That's what the author of Psalm 94 meant when he wrote, "If God disciplines you, consider yourself blessed" or "full of blessings!" To discipline means "to teach." Discipline is not punishment as we understand it - though

it may involve suffering and loss, disappointment and feelings of rejection. When God disciplines us, it is His method to bring us back to live within His commandments and laws and the teachings of Jesus. It is about "getting our attention" when we are overcome by temptation and fall into sin. It's about being confronted by God when He corrects us for allowing the "things or the people or the attractions of this world" to take His place. It is about worshiping those things rather than the Creator of those "things." One of the blessings of discipline is that it has long term benefits for the Christian. If in His mercy He brings loss or suffering to teach us a lesson today, and if we are willing to learn from the loss or suffering when it happens, we will be spared from greater losses or more suffering in the future - and bring more honor to Him.

Putting An End To Polio

(NAPSA)—Here's good news about health: There has never been a more opportune time to finish off polio, with new cases at an all-time low and the wild poliovirus now confined to only a few pockets in Afghanistan, Nigeria and Pakistan—and you can be a part of the solution. In less than a generation, the number of reported cases has fallen by 99 percent, mostly due to mass immunization drives.

The problem, public health experts say, is a \$700 million funding gap that threatens to undermine all the progress achieved against the disease. If the eradication effort stalls now, polio could rebound quickly, potentially paralyzing 250,000 children a year. Unvaccinated children everywhere, including those in countries now polio free, would be at greatly increased risk.

In 1988, Rotary International joined with the World Health Organization, UNICEF and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to launch the Global Polio Eradication Initiative, a worldwide effort to eradicate this crippling childhood disease. To date, Rotary has contributed nearly \$1.2 billion to the effort.

A new, innovative, interactive online campaign gives everyone a chance to support the fight to end polio by joining Archbishop Desmond Tutu, Bill Gates, Jackie Chan, Amanda Peet and other world figures and celebrities already participating in Rotary's "This Close" campaign (as in, "this close" to ending polio) to raise awareness and support for polio eradication.

Earth Day

Earth Day is on April 22 but Earth Month started on April 1st. Although this is not official, maybe it should be! Just one day to celebrate the Earth and adopt lasting, positive changes in our behavior is not enough time. The purpose of Earth Day is to remind people that although the Earth provides every resource that we need in order to live, the Earth needs to be taken care of too. Just being mindful for one day is not enough. Consider this – can every day be Earth Day? Choosing to go through life mindfully with minimal impact makes sense. Suggestions for reducing your impact follow.

Reduce dependence on fossil fuels. We all use them. It is a necessity in the world in which we live. Our lives are powered by energy and fossil fuels have been relatively inexpensive for decades. Despite being commonly used worldwide, fossil fuels damage the Earth in numerous ways. When they spill into the environment, sensitive ecosystems are forever changed. Fracking pumps toxic chemicals into the Earth, polluting local water sources. There is no price high enough to cover the costs of repairing the damage it continues to do to the Earth.

Avoid single-use plastics. They are difficult to avoid when you are at home – but exponentially more difficult when you leave. But that is where planning comes in. Always think ahead to what you will need to eat or drink when you leave the house. Avoid drinking beverages from plastic. We eat, breathe and wear plastics on a daily basis. Reduce your exposure to plastic by avoiding it whenever possible.

Choose sustainably sourced foods and clothes. Clothing made from nylon, polyester and other petroleum fibers releases microplastics into the environment when washed and dried. Eating foods that create undue stress on the Earth contributes to poor health of the environment. Rainforests are being cleared to create additional space to grow cattle and their feed due to the demand for beef. Most of the beef grown is consumed by only 12% of the Earth's population. Buying meats, vegetables and fruits from local farmers reduces the transportation pollution, supports the local economy and has less impact on the environment.

Compost. This is an easy and fun way to manage the organic waste generated in your home. Find a spot in the yard where you can put food waste such as potato peels, eggs shells, coffee grounds and other food waste. Have a source of dried leaves or dirt to sprinkle lightly over the top each time you make a contribution to the pile. The results are amazing! You can turn your food waste into excellent soil full of nutrients for the garden or flower bed. Composting reduces the amount of methane released from landfills because methane is a byproduct of organic waste that decomposes without oxygen. Composting is the best way to manage organic waste generated at home.



Survey Reveals Myths About Back Pain

(NAPSA)—People are so afraid of being told they will need surgery that they may not seek even the most basic help for their back pain.

That's a key finding of a recent member survey of an organization dedicated to improving spine care—the North American Spine Society (NASS).

"It is heartbreaking to see that myths and an unnecessary fear of surgery are holding people back from getting even the most conservative help for their back pain," said Joseph Cheng, MD, MS, associate professor of Neurological Surgery at Vanderbilt University Medical Center and NASS Public

Affairs Committee chair. Most Don't Need Surgery


According to Cheng, the vast majority (90 percent) of people with back pain will get better without treatment or by using conservative treatments, such as anti-inflammatory medication, exercise, coping skills and physical therapy.

Spine surgery is recommended in only about 1 percent of cases, with very specific diagnoses, after a more conservative course of treatment already has been tried.

Back Pain Myths

Despite these facts, patient concerns about potential surgery came up many times throughout the "9 for Spine" survey results. The survey shows that 66 percent of spine specialists surveyed believe that fear of possible treatments, including surgery, keeps their patients from seeking help

for back pain. Many of their patients believe the myth that once you have spine surgery, you are destined to have multiple spine surgeries. The survey also found that over 12 percent of patients wait more than 90

days from the onset of their back pain to seek help from a spine specialist-far longer than the recommended four to six weeks.


Preventing Back Pain

When asked what advice they would offer their patients to prevent back pain, 76 percent of the specialists surveyed stressed the importance of regular exercise and nearly 50 percent urged patients not to smoke.

Said Dr. Cheng, "Right at the top of the list are common sense things like exercising regularly, not smoking, maintaining a healthy body weight and using proper body posture and mechanics when using electronic gadgets or lifting heavy objects."

Thank A Farmer....

As a small scale farmer, there are many days that you work much harder than you actually realize the profit from. Some people want laying age birds but complain about the prices small farmers set for the birds that they've hatched and raised. So, let's do a breakdown of the cost it takes to raise birds from chicks to 6 month old adults.

I did the math for 10 birds. Let's say I purchased straight run chicks from tractor supply at \$7.99 each and I get half drakes and half hens. So start up cost is \$79.90 not counting Uncle Sam's 9% tax on my already taxed dollar. Now our chicks here are raised as naturally as possible. So they get an electrolyte in their water for the first week of life. This is to help boost their immune system. The cost of this from Amazon is a total of \$17.28 for a two pouch order. Now, let me clarify, this pouch lasts for several batches of chicks, but for the sake of this example we'll use the total cost.

The average duckling will eat about 1-1.5 lbs of feed a week for the first 8 weeks. So let's just say our 10 birds eat 1 lb. of feed per week for the first 26 weeks. 26 lbs x 10 birds is 260 lbs. Divide that by 50 lb bags and we get 5.2 bags so we'll just round it out to 5 bags. Chick starter is \$16 a bag so \$16x5 leaves us at \$80 in feed cost.



Running a heat lamp costs on average \$16 a month in electricity. Let's just say it's nice weather and we only have to run the heat lamp for the first few weeks. We're just going to assume we already have a heat lamp and heat lamp bulbs and not add in that cost. We're also not going to count the cost of the bedding, feeders, and waterers. My birds are now 6 months old and it's time to sell to all those people so desperately searching for laying hens. NO DRAKES, I ONLY WANT HENS! Not many want a drake now days. You can't hardly give one away but we'll pretend we're lucky and got \$10 each for our 5 drakes which gives us \$50. We sell our 5 hens for the average price of \$20 each (which is honestly to low). Now it's time for the fun part! Let's do the math! We have \$150 from the sale of the 10 birds. We did pretty good right? We paid \$79.90 and sold them for \$150, that must be a nice profit. But, not so fast. We have \$150 from the sale. We subtract \$16 for the heat lamp which leaves us at \$134. Still not bad. But let's keep going and deduct the \$17.28 in supplements and \$79.90 original purchase price. Let's now subtract our feed cost of \$80. We're now at -\$43.18. Sure doesn't look like much profit to me, especially when it's taken 6 months of daily care to get a mere \$150 for 10 birds. Now, every single bird on my property has either been hatched and raised here or brought in as 3 day old chicks from a reputable hatchery. I've done this to ensure I have only the healthiest possible birds. The point of it all is this, thank a farmer! We didn't choose this lifestyle to make a big profit, we do it because we enjoy it and we like knowing what we're feeding our families. You eat daily because of farmers and if the grocery stores are no longer available, it's people like us you'll be relying on to feed your family. So, don't be so quick to act like our prices are crazy. A little bit of simple math goes a long way.



All About Cheese




According to ancient records passed down through the centuries, the making of cheese dates back more than 4,000 years. No one really knows who made the first cheese. According to an ancient legend, it was made accidentally by an Arabian merchant who put his supply of milk into a pouch made from a sheep's stomach, as he set out on a day's journey across the desert. The rennet in the lining of the pouch, combined with the heat of the sun, caused the milk to separate into curd and whey. That night he found that the whey satisfied his thirst, and the cheese (curd) had a delightful flavor which satisfied his hunger.

Travelers from Asia are believed to have brought the art of cheesemaking to Europe. In fact, cheese was made in many parts of the Roman Empire when it was at its height. The Romans, in turn, introduced cheesemaking to England. During the Middle Ages - from the decline of the Roman Empire until the discovery of America - cheese was made and improved by the monks in the monasteries of Europe. Cheesemaking continued to flourish in Europe and became an established food. In fact, the Pilgrims included cheese in the Mayflower's supplies when they made their voyage to America in 1620. The making of cheese quickly spread in the New World, but until the 19th century it remained a local farm industry. It wasn't until 1851 that the first cheese factory in the United States was built by Jesse Williams in Oneida County, New York. Rising demand for cheese in the U.S. throughout the 1970s and 1980s brought total natural cheese production to more than 6 billion pounds by the beginning of the 1990s. Currently, more than one-third of all milk produced each year in the U.S. is used to manufacture cheese.

Making cheese starts with raw milk. Fat and cream are added, and then it is pateurized to remove any harmful bacteria. At this point, good bacteria or "starter cultures" are added to the milk. The starter cultures ferment the lactose, milk's natural sugar, into lactic acid. This process helps determine the cheese's flavor and texture. Different types of cultures are used to create different types of cheese. After the starter culture, a few other ingredients are added, including rennet and, depending on the type of cheese, color - which is why Cheddar is orange. Rennet causes the milk to gel similarly to yogurt, before the curds (the solids) separate from the whey (the liquid). Once it starts to gel, the cheesemakers cut it, which allows the whey to come out. Once the curds are cut, they're stirred and heated to release even more whey. At this point, the curd is separated from the whey. The cheese is then pressed, more whey comes out, and it eventually becomes the shape and consistency of cheeses we know.

Aging, sometimes called ripening, is the most important stage of cheese production. By allowing cheeses to rest in controlled conditions, they develop the appearance, texture, flavor, and aroma qualities that make them unique. Normally cheeses are aged under controlled conditions from a few days to several years. As a cheese ages, microbes and enzymes transform texture and intensify flavor. This transformation is largely a result of the breakdown of casein proteins and milkfat into a complex mix of amino acids, amines, and fatty acids. Today there are approximately 1,830 +/- known varieties of cheese from 74 countries around the world. They vary greatly in firmness, from the very light consistency of cottage cheese, medium firmness, and all the way to the highly dense and firm varieties.

What To Look For On The Label

How to Read A Food Label


When looking at the label, start with the number of servings per container. If it says there are two servings in the container but you plan on eating the whole thing, you need to multiply all the values listed on the label by two to find out what you're really going to get.

Next, check out the calories. Is it the amount you want to eat? Your body needs calories for energy, but eating more than you need can lead to weight gain.

Look for lots of fiber, vitamin A, vitamin C and calcium. These nutrients will help you stay in good health and help reduce the risk of certain health problems, yet most Americans don't get enough of them.

In fact, the gap between how much fiber Americans should eat and how much they do eat is so big that experts now recommend people eat both fiber-rich and fiber-fortified foods. Foods that provide a good source of fiber should contain 10 percent or more of the Daily Value for fiber.

To find foods that have fiber, look for such ingredients as:

It is important to eat a wide range of dietary fibers from different sources to get all the benefits that fiber can provide. In addition, you should try to limit saturated fat, trans fat and sodium.




