 - 2 cups blueberries

Our President-Elect made many bold promises about imposing sweeping sanctions on goods comina into the

If there is a tariff added to that product, the seller of that product will simply add the 20% to 35%

tariff to the price of the item. The tariff is essentially an additional tax that will be added the purchase



A large portion of products that are made in America contain parts that are imported from other countries. When an American manufacturer purchases imported parts to go into an American made product, that manufacturer will raise the price of that product

to pay for the additional cost of the tariffs. A tariff in this case is a tax that is baked into the cost of many products that we buy, and it is a tax on many American made products.

Tariffs, simply put, raise prices of the products that Americans buy. When prices of goods rise, consumers buy less.



consumers buv less, manufacturers are forced to lay off workers because they have less work for them to do. In

this situation, tariffs eliminate jobs instead of creating them.

If the United States imposes tariffs on imports from Canada, Mexico, and China, those countries will also impose their own tariffs on American imports to their countries, raising the cost of American made products that we export to them. This will cause those countries to buy less American goods, causing a further loss of American jobs.

We, as consumers, pay the cost of tariffs in the form of higher prices, and the Federal Government keeps all of the income from the tariffs. Tariffs are simply new, burdensome taxes on Americans

As Americans, we need to be contacting our elected representatives in Washington,

DC demand that they DO NOT impose these damaging tariffs on things that we buy every day.

The holidays are the time of year when the most trash is generated and discarded than at any time of the year. Extra shopping - both online and in person – contribute to the increase. 

To classify as old growth wood, the wood must contain heartwood which forms after at least 50 years of growth. Old growth wood is far superior to new growth wood. Comparatively, new growth wood reaches maturity in 10 to 20 years. The goal with new wood is to grow the wood as quickly as possible.

- Old growth wood is generally stronger, more durable, and more resistant to rot than new growth wood:
- Old growth wood is denser than new growth wood, which makes it sturdier and able to support heavier loads for longer.
- Old growth trees grow more slowly, which results in a higher proportion of latewood, or fall and summer growth. This latewood gives old growth wood
- its natural rot-resistant properties. Old growth trees have tighter growth rings, which makes the wood more robust and less likely to shrink and expand.
- Old growth trees develop heartwood in the middle, which is also rot-resistant and strong.
- Old growth wood is rare and unique, and many pieces come from trees with a lot of history. The quality of new lumber is

worse than old, is true ... However, new growth wood is cheaper and easier to find than old growth wood. New growth wood can also be used for structural support in renovation projects if it's designed correctly.


