# Recipe Korner

## **New-Fashioned Sausage Cassoulet**

(NAPSA)—If you're one of those people who order cassoulet whenever you see it on the menu, you have lots of company. Most people love cassoulet and order it because it's a dish they think is hard to make at home. Well, here's a recipe that shows this French dish is really simple to make yet complex in flavor:

## New-Fashioned Sausage Cassoulet

Yield: 4

1 teaspoon olive oil

½ pound fully cooked smoked sausage, cut in 2-inch lengths

- ½ pound fresh Italian sausage links, cut in 2-inch lengths
- 2 cups chopped onion
- 3 cloves garlic, peeled and minced
- 1 (28-ounce) can diced tomatoes including liquid
- 1 teaspoon dried thyme leaves
- ½ teaspoon dried rosemary, crushed
- 2 whole bay leaves
- 1/4 teaspoon ground cloves
- 1 (14- to 15-ounce) can white beans (cannellini or great northern), drained and rinsed
- 1. Heat oil in a large, heavy skillet over medium heat. Add sausages and sauté until brown, about 10 minutes. With a slotted spoon, transfer sausages to drain in a paper towel-lined bowl.



This delicious cassoulet is simple to make and complex in flavor.

- 2. Discard all but 1 teaspoon pan drippings. Add onion to hot pan drippings and cook until tender. Add garlic and sauté only until fragrant, about 30-40 seconds.
- 3. Stir in tomatoes with liquid, thyme, rosemary, bay leaves, cloves and beans.
- 4. Bring mixture to a gentle boil. Return sausage to pan. Cover and gently simmer for 30 to 40 minutes to allow flavors to develop.
- 5. Remove bay leaves. Serve cassoulet in individual shallow soup bowls.

As a result, an estimated 248 million hours, (which collectively equates to 10.3 million days or 339,000 months) were wasted answering spam calls in the last 12 months alone.

The majority of these calls are related to credit card fraud, identity theft, medicare/insurance, social security, car warranty and debt collection. Many people are not able to accurately recognize unwanted communication, allowing spammers or scammers to trap their victims.

Here are three tips to help you handle such scams:

1. Hang up. When you get a robocall, don't press any numbers to let you

speak to a live operator or remove you from their call list. It might lead to more robocalls.

2. Consider call blocking or a call labeling app such as Truecaller. Since 2009, Truecaller, a leader in caller ID and spam blocking software, has been a global combatant against spam and fraud, tirelessly working to safeguard communication for all.

Its easy-to-use app can:

- · Auto-block spam calls and SMSs

- 3. Don't trust your caller ID: Scammers can make any name or number show up on your caller ID. That's called spoofing. Even if it looks like it's a government agency, or like the call is from a local number, it could be a scammer from anywhere in the world.

# Truth About Trash by Lisa Luck



- Every person in Tennessee generates about 2,000 pounds worth of garbage each year. Most of that goes into the trash. Waste can be reduced to 500 pounds per person per year if that person takes the time to recycle (50%) and compost (25%).

Approximately 99% of the materials we buy are discarded within six months. According to the EPA, the total garbage collected in 2018 in the U.S. was 292.4 million tons.

Many of the products we purchase are environmentally toxic and cause a variety of health problems. Products can cause diabetes, heart disease, cancer, hormone disruptions, birth defects and infertility. Read the labels before purchasing products to assure your safety and the safety of your family.

Waste from products pollute our air, water and soil. All waste must be managed properly to avoid unnecessary exposure to all living creatures.

Only 9% of all plastics that have been manufactured are recycled. Degrading plastics now cover the entire earth. Plastic bits, called microplastics or nanoplastics depending on size, can be found in every ecosystem and are distributed throughout the earth via air and water. All living beings are affected by plastic waste.

Keep America Beautiful estimates that there are approximately 50 billion pieces of litter discarded along roadways and waterways in the United States.

Cigarette butts are litter, too, and can take up to 18 years to decompose. According to Keep America Beautiful, cigarette butts make up about 38% of litter found in the U.S.

According to the Environmental Working Group (EWG), women are exposed to 168 chemicals every day through cosmetics and personal care products while men are exposed to 85 chemicals per day. EWG states, "... personal care products contain carcinogens, pesticides, reproductive toxins, endocrine disruptors, plasticizers, degreasers and surfactants."

Reading labels to find a natural and nontoxic product can be difficult. Many manufacturers say they are "all natural" but still contain toxins.

Pesticides pollute soil, air and water. Approximately one billion pounds of pesticides are used annually in the United States.

Indoor air can be more toxic than outside air due to the number of chemicals used in the home. Cleaning supplies release the most chemicals and can cause respiratory and other issues.

Fireworks pollute the air, soil and water. They impact both humans and animals through noise, smoke and debris strewn across land and water. The dust contains particles of heavy metals including cadmium, lithium, barium, dioxins, strontium, aluminum, rubidium and perchlorates and lead that settle in the environment.

Human activity affects our environment and the health of all living beings. Managing waste properly is essential to reversing the impact we have on the earth. Conserving our natural resources is the most pressing issue we all currently face because our resources will determine the quality of our futures. Remember the words of Dr. Seuss in The Lorax, "Unless someone like you cares a whole awful lot, nothing is going to get better. It's not."
