

Managing Heart Failure Is Worth The Effort

A study by the American Heart Association shows people with HF report spending more time on managing their condition; free app aims to make it easier

(NAPSA)—The American Heart Association, the world's leading voluntary health organization dedicated to building healthier lives, free of cardiovascular diseases and stroke, shared this month that more heart failure patients and their caregivers report they are putting more effort into managing this complex condition. In 2015, just 55 percent of survey respondents said they were working harder to manage HF. The latest study shows a 14-point increase, with 69 percent now putting effort toward the important daily task of managing heart failure.



The AHA conducted its annual survey as part of the Rise Above Heart Failure initiative, nationally supported by Novartis Pharmaceuticals Corporation, and found that while those diagnosed with heart failure and their caregivers are spending more time and energy managing the disease, they are benefiting. These two groups showed an increased understanding of heart failure since the survey was last conducted.

"It's important to understand heart failure or any condition you have been diagnosed with," says John Osborne, M.D., cardiologist and American Heart Association volunteer. "It allows you to ask better questions of your healthcare providers and take an active role in your health."

Through Rise Above Heart Failure, people living with heart failure can access free tools to help make the daily task of managing medications, symptoms and doctor's visits simpler. This includes an app called HF Path, designed to keep all aspects of heart failure management at a patient's—or caregiver's—fingertips.

Heart failure, which occurs when the heart is not able to efficiently pump blood around the body, can cause symptoms like breathlessness, persistent coughing, swelling and fatigue. "It's important for heart failure patients to track their symptoms day to day so they can alert their healthcare provider to any warning signs of worsening HF and get prompt treatment," said Osborne. "World Heart Day serves as a great reminder to us all to make a promise to better understand and advocate for our own health."

Got Stress? Ancient Music May Be Cure

(NAPSA)—Although doctors at Harvard University found that just one bout with anger can increase the risk for heart attack within two hours for those prone to irregular heart rhythms, there are behavioral strategies to help people keep their cool and protect their heart. For many, that chill factor comes in the unusual form of chanting and listening to ancient mantras.

For The Birds by Lisa Luck



It is finally spring and the birds are super busy. They spend the day gathering small twigs, bits of plastic, and other construction materials to build their nests. Birds, when working together as a couple, can get a lot done in a short period of time. Next comes the waiting as the birds sit on the nest. Doesn't seem very long to us but for a mother bird -- just sitting there -- it probably seems endless. But that's actually the calm before the storm. The wide-open beaks of the little ones will line the nest soon and require one trip after another to keep them fed and quiet. It is a joy to watch the different birds building their nests and gathering food all around the yard.

It seems like a wonderful life. Birds don't have to focus on anything past or present. They live in the moment, doing what needs to be done so they can thrive and reproduce. It is not always as easy as it sounds. There are many dangers they must face as they go through their day-to-day activities. Cats are ever-present and ever-watching – waiting for a busy bird to become distracted. Their quick paws and sharp teeth make a quick end for an unsuspecting bird that sits too low on a bush, or pecks at worms on the ground. According to the American Bird Conservancy, approximately 2.4 billion birds are killed annually by domesticated cats. A cat's presence in a yard can impact the health of the birds by reducing nesting habits. Humane World for Animals estimate there are 30 to 40 million cats that live outdoors in the United States. Many of these are not spayed or neutered so have numerous kittens over their lifespan. Cats are the primary reason bird populations are decreasing.

The bright night lights that line city sidewalks and roadways are another danger for birds. Just like for people, the bright lights disrupt their circadian rhythms and interfere with their getting enough sleep. In the last couple of years, the city has installed bright lights that have changed the birds behavior in our neighborhood. Instead of the birds waking up at 5:00 am to start their day, they now awaken around 3:00 to 3:30 am. This can cause stress and shorten the lifespan of a bird. Migrating birds are at special risk because artificial lights can cause them to become disoriented. They can lose their way and become too exhausted to continue migrating to their destination. Bright lights at night can cause them to collide with buildings or windows as they head toward the light.

We can help our bird friends by keeping cats indoors and by turning out the lights at night. This will protect our bird populations. Birds are important to humans. They are pollinators and can assist in increasing harvests. They disperse seeds throughout the environment for a healthy ecosystem. They also eat many insects preventing infestations. A bonus is that they are fascinating to watch.

America's Spam Scorecard

(NAPS)—The next time your phone rings, there's a good chance it will be a spam call—but there are ways you can protect yourself.

The Problem

The average person sees around 9 spam calls a month. According to the experts at Truecaller, a global combatant against spam and fraud, Americans wasted an estimated 272 million hours, (that's 11 million days, or 373,000 months) answering spam calls in the last 12 months alone. And since the average spam call lasts about 4 minutes, spammers and scammers have plenty of time to trap their victims.

So, Who's Calling?

Between regular sales calls, robocalls from legitimate businesses, online surveys, political or donation calls and outright scams, unwanted calls—some with malicious intent—make up a large part of ordinary communication. Among these, most were related to credit card fraud, identity theft, Medicare/insurance, Social Security, car warranty and debt collection.

Where The Calls Come From

While a majority of spam calls (89.84%) made to Americans originate from within the U.S. (or, at least, seem to), over 75 percent of rest are from India, nearly 5 percent from Nigeria, and the rest mostly from Colombia, South Africa, Mexico and Egypt

Who Can Help

Truecaller sees it as its mission to empower consumers with the knowledge to protect themselves from unwanted calls and the ability to identify and block them.

What You Can Do

It's important to install protective software on your mobile devices, just as you would on your computers. To handle spam on Truecaller: Enable the autoblock feature to automatically decline calls from known spammers, manually block numbers by searching for them in the app and marking them as spam,

and report suspicious numbers to help Truecaller's database identify future spam calls. You can also customize your blocking level to choose whether to block only "top spammers" or all identified spam numbers. That way you can answer most calls with the confidence of knowing your phone has screened out the spam.

In addition, the Federal Communications Commission says:

- Be aware: Caller ID showing a "local" number does not necessarily mean it is .
- Don't respond to any questions, especially those that can be answered with "Yes."
- Never give out personal information such as account numbers, Social Security numbers, mother's maiden names, passwords or other identifying information in response to unexpected calls or if you are at all suspicious.
- If you get an inquiry from someone who says they represent a company or a government agency, hang up and call the phone number on your account statement, or on the company's or government agency's website to verify the authenticity of the request.




