Menopause and Dry Eye: What Women Need to Know

(NAPS)—It may seem surprising to some but dry eye is one of the most common conditions women going through the menopause experience.

"Dry eye is a complicated eye condition with various causes. It affects men and women of all ages, but women entering menopause are more likely to experience dry eye because of hormonal changes affecting the eye," said Purnima Patel, MD, an ophthalmologist and volunteer for EyeCare America®, a program offering no-cost eye exams to uninsured or underinsured Americans.

Dry eye disease is a common condition that happens when your tears don't adequately lubricate your eyes. When you blink, tears spread over the surface of the eye. This keeps the eye smooth, clear and comfortable. Dry eye can happen when you don't produce enough tears, when you produce poor-quality tears, or your tears dry out too quickly. It can lead to red, irritated, tired or painful eyes.

Why Is Dry Eye More Common During Menopause?

During menopause, the body produces less of the hormones estrogen and progesterone. Hormonal changes during menopause are likely linked to dry eye disease, but the exact mechanism is not known, and more research is needed. In general, dry eye can result from lower tear production and reduced lubrication from the eye's oil glands. This can cause a scratchy feeling or light sensitivity, making it hard to read or drive at night. It can also cause blurry vision.

What Should You Do if You Have Dry Eye?

Artificial tears, also known as lubricating eye drops, are the most common treatment for dry eye. Most are available without a prescription. It's important to note that drops with preservatives can irritate your eyes if you use them too much. If you need artificial tears more than a few times a day, use drops without preservatives. These come in single-serving droppers. Warm compresses on the eyelids are another at-home treatment.

For some people, a few simple lifestyle changes can resolve dry eye. If you live in a dry place, consider using a humidifier. Direct fans away from your eyes. Take regular breaks from computers and smart phones. Protect your eyes

from the wind by wearing wrap-around glasses outside. If you wake up with dry and scratchy eyes, use thicker eye drops such as an artificial tear ointment or gel just before you go to bed.

When Should You See a Doctor About Dry Eye?

If your dry eye is severe, visit an ophthalmologist to help determine the cause and the best treatment options for you. Based on your examination, your ophthalmologist may recommend a prescription eye drop or ointment, tiny plugs inserted into the eyelids to help keep tears in the eye longer, or other medications.

Ophthalmologists are physicians who specialize in medical and surgical eye care. During an eye exam, an ophthalmologist will look at your eyelids and the surface of the eye and determine the amount and quality of your tears.

"Not sure why you're experiencing dry eye? Maybe you've tried over-the-counter drops, but your eyes are still bothering you? It's best to see a doctor to figure out the cause of dry eye," Dr. Patel said. "If you already use eye drops for dry eye and have been using the drops more than three times a day, that may be a sign to check in with your ophthalmologist about an additional treatment option that may work better for you."



Food & Pesticides by Lisa Luck



We are quickly approaching the time of plenty. Plenty of fruits, vegetables and herbs. It's almost corn season and tomato season at the Farmer's Market is definitely here. A diet rich in fruits and vegetables is essential for good health. Fresh produce can be purchased as either conventionally or organically grown. Conventionally grown produce uses pesticides, herbicides and other chemicals to assist in the growing, harvesting and transporting processes. Organic vegetables are typically grown without pesticides, herbicides or other chemicals, although the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) has approved some pesticides for use on organic produce. The approved pesticides are made from natural substances rather than made by humans using chemicals.

Whether food is conventionally or organically grown, it is important to wash produce before consuming. Even if you intend to peel the item before consuming, wash the produce. This prevents the introduction of contamination to edible parts by bacteria or chemicals when it is cut. Wash well under running water for about ten to fifteen seconds. Scrub produce that is firm. Commercial washes or scrubs are not recommended as they can introduce even more chemicals to the food. After washing, dry the produce and then it can be used.

The Environmental Working Group (EWG) tests nonorganic produce for pesticide levels and determines which foods are most contaminated. The list is called the "Dirty Dozen," and is compiled for publication each year. Following are fruits and vegetables listed in the order of those containing the most pesticides to those containing the least: spinach, strawberries, greens (kale, mustard greens, collards), grapes, peaches, cherries, nectarines, pears, apples, blackberries, blueberries and potatoes. Washing these well before peeling or consuming them is important to limit your exposure to pesticides. Buying this produce organically is recommended whenever possible or if it is a product your family consumes a lot.

Foods least likely to be contaminated by pesticides although they are commercially grown are called the "Clean Fifteen." They are listed in the order of least pesticides: pineapple, corn (fresh/frozen), avocados, papaya, onions, sweet peas (frozen), asparagus, cabbage, watermelon, cauliflower, bananas, mangoes, carrots, mushrooms and kiwi. Eating these products grown organically is not as important since pesticide levels are much lower. The EWG found that approximately 60% of produce on this list contained no detectable levels of pesticides.

Exposure to pesticides can result in a number of health problems. Exposure contributes to premature birth, spontaneous abortions, lowered sperm counts, heart disease and cancer. Young children exposed to pesticides have poorer neuro-development than other children. Pesticide levels can be measured in

Although organic food is typically more expensive than commercially grown food, prices can be comparable when shopping locally at a Farmer's Market rather than from a supermarket or grocery store. Growing organic crops builds healthy soil and protects the pollinators that are necessary for most crops. For good health, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) recommends eating approximately two cups of fruit and three cups of vegetables each day. Eat a varied diet.




Slow Cooker Chicken Tacos


Can you use chicken thighs instead of breasts?

Yes! Boneless, skinless chicken thighs work great in this recipe. Just use about 4 1/2 pounds and you'll be set.



Stored in an airtight container in the refrigerator, the chicken will stay good for up to three days. Any longer, and it's best





To freeze some for future meals, let the chicken cool to room temperature (for no more than two hours) and portion into airtight containers or freezer-safe zip-top bags. Freeze for up to three months. To use, let it let thaw overnight (or up to three days) in the refrigerator. Reheat in a saucepan on the stove until the liquid is simmering.

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. In a 6- to 8-quart slow cooker, stir together the tomato sauce, chili powder, cumin, salt, paprika, pepper, garlic, and onion until well combined. Add the chicken, stirring to ensure it is fully coated with the sauce.
- 2. Cover and cook until the chicken is cooked through and the internal temperature of the chicken is 165°F, on low for 4 to 6 hours or on high for 2 to 3 hours.
- 3. Remove the chicken to a large cutting board. When it is cool enough to handle, cut it into bite-sized pieces. Return the chicken to the sauce and stir very well.
- 4. Cover and cook on low for 15 minutes more.
- 5. Serve on tortillas topped with lettuce, tomatoes, cheese, sour cream, and salsa.

Tip: This recipe makes about three quarts of chicken taco meat.





Looking Out For Your Lungs: The Importance of Lung Cancer Screening


"The advantage of them finding it so early is that I had a lot more treatment options. I was able to have surgery, chemotherapy, qualify for a clinical trial. One of the advantages of early detection is that the goal of treatment becomes a cure as opposed to palliative. And I had so many treatment options."

Understanding the Low-Dose CT Scan

The scan itself is quite straightforward and not scary. A low-dose CT scan is a type of X-ray that captures multiple images as you lie on a table that smoothly slides in and out of the machine. The process is open and non-claustrophobic, taking less than 10 minutes to complete. Although any screening can be emotionally challenging, getting the scan done early provides individuals with more treatment options if needed and peace of mind.



God spoke so clearly to me as I was putting a coat of clear varnish on this piece of furniture - so here is 'our' story.





I remember when I was a young child how much I enjoyed looking at small insects with a magnifying glass. All their small parts, colors, and patterns were so easy to see with the help of magnification. A magnifying glass focuses on objects and makes them appear to be larger than they actually are. This can also be the case in life, as we choose which parts of our lives we choose to focus on and make larger and more important. We can choose to give more attention to the struggles and problems in our lives than to the blessings. As with the magnifying glass, this kind of attention makes the struggles and problems appear to be larger than they are. If we continue to focus our attention in this manner, the struggles in life will make our blessings appear to be much smaller, and more difficult to see. We all have to deal with problems, grief, and serious challenges in life, but we do have the ability to choose what parts of our lives get the larger part of our attention: our troubles or our blessings. If we choose to give our blessings the larger part of our attention, then we will be thankful and fulfilled in life, making us better able to overcome

the challenges of life every day.

A wise person once said, "Do the math; count your blessings." Overall, the math comes out in our favor. Regardless of how


