#### Upcoming National Museum To Honor All Soldiers

(NAPS)—If you or someone you know is a soldier, Army veteran, Army family member or other proud military supporter, you can become a permanent part of history at the National Museum of the United States Army.

An historic project led by the Army Historical Foundation and the U.S. Army, the Museum is going up at Fort Belvoir, Va., just south of Washington, D.C.

"We are proud to build a national museum that will tell the history of the

Army—and our nation—through the eyes of American soldiers," said Foundation President U.S. Army Retired Lt. Gen. Roger Schultz. "The timeline for opening the Museum was delayed because of the COVID-19 pandemic, but we promise it will be worth the wait."

To be included in the Museum's story, soldiers and Army veterans can submit their stories of service in the Registry of the American Soldier, which will be one of the largest collections of American Soldier profiles ever assembled. Stories can also be submitted on a veteran's behalf, at no cost. The Foundation currently features the Registry on its website and the collection will be made available on kiosks in the Museum. Stories can be submitted at www.armyhistory.org/the-registries/.

Members of the Army community can also be a permanent part of the Museum by ordering a customized commemorative brick to be laid on the grounds of the Museum. More than 8,000 bricks have already been installed, honoring soldiers from all 50 states. Among the bricks are those for such well-known Army veterans as Senator Bob Dole and General Eric Shinseki. Individuals and organizations can order bricks at www.armyhistory.org/bricks.

Hints For Homeowners

#### Work At Home In Comfort And Safety

(NAPS)—According to Darrell Smith, executive director of the International Window Film Association, window film makes a lot of sense for homeowners eager to save money on their energy bills.

"Solar-control films can block as much as 80 percent of the solar heat coming through glass into a building, decrease the heat load on the air-conditioning system and reduce energy costs," Smith says.



#### Window film can be a bright idea for home workers and students, as it blocks UV rays, saves on cooling costs and lets in natural sunlight.

With more people working and studying from home, window film allows in abundant natural sunlight while blocking 99 percent of the sun's harmful UV rays to better protect the skin (from possible cancer) and eyes (from cataract development), while reducing the fading of floors and furnishings. Smith estimates that 40 to 60 percent of color fading is caused by UV exposure. Windows may also be upgraded for safety, as window film helps to hold glass pieces together if the window is impacted and broken.

For even a 3,000 square foot home, window film may be installed in a day or less with minimal disruption. Window film installers clean the glass before installation, keep the work space clean and practice safe contact as recommended by the Centers for Disease Control. ## **Plastics Disposal** by Lisa Luck



Plastic is the most versatile material ever invented. Primarily made from petroleum products such as natural gas, coal or crude oil, it can be formed and molded into unlimited sizes, shapes, colors or strengths. Mass production of plastic products ushered in the age of consumerism. Plastic products shaped into furniture, dishes, bottles, and later nylon, allowed even those who "have not" to "have," as products were much less expensive to acquire than those made from animal horns, turtle shells or rubber. Plastic products replaced many of those made from metals which was needed for World War II efforts. Although plastic can also be made from cellulose from plants, it is much more commonly made from fossil fuels.

If it sounds too good to be true – it's because it is. Proper disposal of products made from plastic was not considered during the manufacturing process. Plastic products were discarded along with other materials and either burned, buried or put into landfills. In the 1970's, the concept of recycling plastics was introduced as scientists noticed it was accumulating in our oceans. Efforts to recycle plastics have not been successful and less than 10% of all plastic ever made is recycled. Even the plastic that is recycled once or twice still goes to the landfill. The worst kind of plastic for the environment is the kind that is made for single use. Packaging used to store a serving of water or food is discarded within minutes after being opened. The increase in use of single-use plastic is responsible for the rise in plastic pollution.

Plastic does not decompose once it is discarded. It breaks down into microplastics and nanoplastics. Nanoplastics cannot be seen with the naked eye and can travel through the air and water. Plastic particles are not only found in our oceans, but can now be found in the bodies of all living things. We all contain plastic because we eat it in our foods, drink it in our water, and breathe it from the air.

Recycling plastic was the recommended method of managing plastic waste. However, the consensus is that plastic waste cannot be easily managed through recycling. The only other alternative is to stop using plastic whenever possible. Buy products that can be used a lifetime instead of just once. A stainless steel thermos can be washed and reused. Avoid Styrofoam to-go boxes and cups by taking your own stainless steel or ceramic containers or cups with you. Styrofoam is one of the worst plastics because it breaks down so easily in the environment. In addition, it leaches chemicals into foods or beverages. Purchasing plastic made from plant cellulose rather than cellulose from fossil fuels will decrease your exposure to plastic and decrease the amount of plastic waste that accumulates on earth.

It is estimated that more than 440 million tons of plastic are produced annually. Most of this will become part of the pollution problem unless we refuse to use plastics. Look for substitutes. Avoid plastic products whenever possible.

## Steak and Broccoli Stir Fry

#### Ingredients

2 tablespoon grapeseed oil or other cooking oil

1 pound ribeye steak, cut into bite-sized pieces

salt and freshly ground black pepper to taste

1 cups soy sauce, or more as needed

1/2 cup honey

1/4 cup sesame oil

4 garlic cloves, chopped

2 tablespoons fresh ginger, chopped

1 shallot, chopped

1 1/2 cups fresh broccoli florets

2 green onions, chopped, for garnish

#### Directions

Step 1

Heat grapeseed oil in a cast iron skillet over medium heat. Season steak with salt and pepper.

#### Step 2

Add steak to skillet and cook for 1 to 2 minutes on each side. Remove from heat and set aside.

#### Step 3

Whisk soy sauce, honey, sesame oil, garlic, ginger, and shallot together in a bowl. Pour sauce into the skillet and bring to a gentle simmer. Add broccoli and cook for 2 minutes.

Add steak back into the skillet; cook until hot, 1 to 2 minutes. Sprinkle with chopped green onions to serve.
