





Five Things To Avoid To Help Your Heart

(NAPSA)—Managing blood pressure well can add years of life for the nearly 80 million American adults who have high blood pressure, according to the American Heart Association (AHA). But there are some things that you may not realize are sabotaging your efforts to keep your blood pressure in a healthy range.

What To Watch Out For

- 1. Decongestants: According to the AHA, people with high blood pressure should be aware that the use of decongestants may raise blood pressure. Many over-the-counter cold and flu preparations contain decongestants such as oxymetazoline, phenylephrine and pseudoephedrine, which increase blood pressure.
- 2. Sleep apnea: Some 12 million Americans have sleep apnea, according to National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute estimates. It's a potentially lifethreatening sleep disorder in which tissues in the throat collapse and block the airway. The brain forces the sleeper awake enough to cough or gulp air. Pauses in breathing can contribute to severe fatigue during the day. Sleep apnea is also a risk factor for such medical problems as high blood pressure, heart failure, diabetes and stroke.
- 3. Stress: In addition to the emotional discomfort you feel when faced with a stressful situation, your body reacts by releasing stress hormones (adrenaline and cortisol) into the blood. These prepare the body for the "fight or flight response" by making the heart beat faster and constricting blood vessels. Constriction of blood vessels and increase in heart rate do raise blood pressure, temporarily; when the stress reaction goes away, blood pressure returns to its pre-stress level. Chronic stress can cause your body to go into high gear on and off for days or weeks at a time. And while it may not directly cause high blood pressure, chronic stress can lead to unhealthy lifestyle choices that do affect your blood pressure. It's important to handle your stress in a healthy way, especially if you already have high blood pressure.
- 4. Sodium: In some people, sodium increases blood pressure because it holds excess fluid in the body, placing an added burden on the heart. If your

Writing things down or using a health-tracking app will make managing your medications a lot easier. "Remember that you're on blood pressure-lowering medicine for a reason. Stopping, skipping, or taking them differently can increase your risk of debilitating or deadly consequences such as stroke or heart attack," said Raymond Townsend, M.D., an AHA spokesperson and director of the Hypertension Program at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia. "If you think you need to do something differently, talk to your health care provider first, before making a change that could change your life." Learn More

Waste Management by Lisa Luck



Waste is defined by the Oxford Languages Dictionary as, "... a material, substance, or byproduct) eliminated or discarded as no longer useful or required after the completion of a process." All life on earth creates waste. Some of the waste is generated as we breathe, eat or even sleep and must be excreted. Other waste is created through the activities in which living beings engage.

Waste is the greatest problem facing mankind. In developed countries, each person generates approximately 20 tons of waste annually. In less developed countries, each person generates approximately 8 tons of waste annually. The above-mentioned tonnage includes all waste such as greenhouse gases, solid waste, waste from bodily functions including respiration, waste from travel, agriculture and any other activity in which humans participate.

Capture and disposal of waste generated by human activity is one of the greatest challenges we currently face. Eight billion plus residents living on earth require the minimum basics of shelter, food and energy. Achieving these minimums generates a significant amount of waste in addition to all of the products that are purchased such as cell phones, vehicles and clothing. Humans are consumers. Many of us like the newest, the best and the most of anything and everything. Out with the old and in with the new is the attitude of many millions of people. The amount of waste currently being generated is overwhelming man-made systems put in place to manage this waste. Landfills are reaching capacity and closing. Establishing new landfills requires money. New technology for managing waste is needed because each year more waste is generated.

Most people do not think about waste. It is human nature that once one has decided something is garbage and needs to be discarded, an effort to get rid of it is overpowering. Some cannot wait until they get to a trash can so throw it out a car window. Others can't wait to take furniture to ReStore or Goodwill so they throw it over the edge of a ravine. Bulky, heavy or hard to dispose of items invite some people to chunk their trash into a river or stream. This exacerbates the problem downstream. Waste that is not managed properly affects all of us. Improperly managed waste pollutes the air, soil and water. Illegally dumped waste lowers property values and invites crime into a neighborhood due to negligence. It can also cause disease.

All waste management processes have federal and state laws regulating disposal of wastes that must be followed. Despite regulations, some wastes are not managed properly. When waste is not managed properly, it will inevitably impact human health and contaminate the environment.

In Tennessee, each resident generates approximately 2,000 pounds (one ton) of waste annually. Fifty percent of what is generated – if properly sorted and clean – can be recycled. Twenty five percent of waste generated can be composted. The remaining twenty-five percent of waste can be reduced by refusing, reusing, or repairing existing products. Learning how to manage waste properly is crucial.
