Interesting Fall Fun Facts....

- ⇒ Those who live closest to the equator, which is the center of the planet, never experience the season of autumn. Around the equator, the temperature remains consistently warm.
- ⇒ Yellow, orange and variations thereof always reside in the pigmentation of tree leaves, but they are just overpowered by the abundance of green from the chlorophyll in the leaves. Come autumn, however, when the sun weakens and days grow shorter, the amount of chlorophyll in leaves diminishes, allowing the other pigments in the leaves to show through.
- ⇒ Red and purple leaves are actually caused by the presence of sugars from sap that is trapped inside of the leaves.
- ⇒ Fall is a peak migration time for many species of birds. During autumn, birds will fly to other areas as they seek more hospitable climates. The Arctic tern journeys about 11,000 miles each way for its annual migration. That is like going all the way across the United States about three and a half times.
- Contrary to popular belief, squirrels who have spent the entire autumn collecting acorns and other foods do not hibernate for the winter. Rather, they spend the majority of their time in nests they built to shelter them from harsh weather. When squirrels do come out in winter, they are usually tunneling under the snow to find the food they buried during the

Sprinkle tree with decorating sugar; place tree on baking sheet. Continue to make the rest of the trees. Pipe frosting on trees to make a garland, then decorate them with colorful candies.

Serving suggestion: Place each tree on a sugar cookie and decorate your serving tray with shredded coconut to resemble snow.







Substitutions for Plastic by Lisa Luck



Worldwide, the suggested solution for disposal of plastic waste is to recycle. Theoretically, that sounds great! Use a plastic product, put it in a recycling bin and it will be made into another plastic product. This is a simplistic approach to managing plastic waste. The reality is that many of the plastics we use on a regular basis cannot be recycled. Some are toxic (hospital plastic waste, straws), others are not easily recycled (plastics #3-7). Others are not recycled correctly.


If plastic containers are dirty, greasy, or the wrong type of plastic – they contaminate the other plastics in a recycling bin. This makes one of two things happen. 1) It soils all the containers in the bin so all of it has to be discarded instead of recycled. 2) It has to be removed by hand and thrown away which increases the cost of recycling. Ultimately, too much contamination in a bin prevents recycling even if many people are doing it correctly. It is nationally estimated that approximately 30% of plastic collected for recycling is trash – not recyclable materials. Locally, I would suspect that number is higher.


The best solution for plastic waste is not to create it in the first place. Yes, it takes thought and planning to avoid plastic. It is not always convenient to do so. In the grocery store, buying milk or juice in cardboard containers instead of plastic containers is a good start. Although the cardboard containers cannot be recycled, they have less impact on the environment throughout their life than plastics do. Buy powered clothes soap packaged in a box instead of soap in large plastic jugs. The jugs contain more water than soap.

One disposable product frequently used as a substitute for Styrofoam or plastic is paper cups. What could be harmful about paper cups, right? Oh, let me count the ways ... Paper cups are coated with a very thin layer of plastic. When they are littered, the plastic from those cups is dispersed throughout the environment, just like from plastic cups. The layer of plastic contains numerous chemicals that leach into a hot beverage along with the microplastics from the thin plastic layer. When a hot beverage is consumed we are drinking numerous toxic substances along with it. The paper cups cannot be recycled or composted. They must go into the trash. Get in a habit of taking your own coffee cup to work, while traveling, or to church. Encourage the groups and organizations you are a part of to commit to not using disposable products at all.

I was appalled to go to a conference not too long ago and see that plastic water bottles, plastic cups and plastic silverware were still being distributed to participants. I was disappointed to see how many people still willingly accepted water served in these toxic containers. Taking your own water in a stainless steel water bottle is the best choice for the environment and for your health. Refuse to use products containing plastic.

Newspapers Are Alive And Well And Thriving In the Suburbs

As the world has become increasingly digital, print marketing has kept pace or exceeded performance of online offerings. With fewer printed publications and fewer pages being printed, the value of information in newspapers has increased, due to a greater likelihood of being seen, as people are more easily able to read small, suburban community newspapers, cover to cover in a short amount of time. The



digital versions of newspapers often have many more pages, as there is comparatively little cost to adding more and more content online.

As online publications are inundated with thousands of requests per day for inclusion of branded content, and the volume of site traffic remains relatively stable, the value of each individual placement in the online versions of newspapers is diminished and diluted by the influx of new information.

The visibility of the printed word as compared with the value of the same word in online versions, has always been far greater, by any measure, which is reflected in the cost of getting seen in newspapers in print versus the digital publication. The printed versions can easily be shared online as many are replicated as a pdf version on an affiliated digital site with social media channels. Some take a picture of articles to share.

All things considered, here are five good reasons to add print media to your marketing mix:

- 1- Printed Newspapers Trigger Multiple Senses: Many people seek time away from touching their mobile phones, computer keyboards, and TV remote controls. It's nice to get the feel of a printed newspaper or magazine, with glossy pages, the smell of the ink, and the sounds of the pages flipping, which have been simulated online in digital flip books, by popular demand. It's easier to see a printed page in bright sunlight, instead of the glare or reflection on a screen.
- 2- Print Engages More Readily: Content that lives online doesn't engage as well if it is in an abbreviated format, requiring readers to click through to another page to see the rest of the article. Many readers are impatient when reading online, feeling they don't have time to stop and read a whole article or blog post, so they merely skim, scan and move on to the next. Print readers tend to slow down and actually read, not only the news, but also the ads, especially those that are native and relevant to the adjacent articles they read.
- 3- Brains React Differently To Paper Than Screens: The human brain processes information differently depending on the presentation in print or on a screen. Readers of print have longer attention spans because screens have far more distractions. The act of deep reading, which occurs more naturally in print, creates deep thinking, which means readers can become fully engrossed in the content. When readers see relevant sponsored content next to the publisher generated content, they are more easily swayed to think about that as well.
- 4- Print Drives Online Engagement: To get people to take action and interact more with your brand, you can capture attention in printed media and drive your audience to your online assets.
- 5- Adding Newspapers To The Mix Increases ROI: For the message you worked so hard to craft and deliver online, you can get more mileage out of it, for very little extra cost, by covering print media, to reach more people in your target audience, and to achieve goal oriented outcomes.
