



Diabetes: A Silent Threat—and How the American Red Cross is Taking Action

(NAPS)—Diabetes affects millions of Americans and is a leading cause of serious complications, including kidney failure, lower-limb amputations, adult blindness, and an increased risk of heart disease and stroke. Yet many people remain unaware they're at risk.

Genetics, lifestyle habits, and limited access to healthcare all contribute to this growing health crisis.

This November, in honor of Diabetes Awareness Month and its theme—"Taking Action to Prevent Diabetes-Related Health Problems"—the American Red Cross is offering free A1C screenings to all blood donors who haven't received the test in the past 12 months. The initiative is already making a difference. Since March, the Red Cross has provided approximately 550,000 A1C screenings, notifying 145,000 individuals about concerning results. About 1 in 5 donors tested had results in the prediabetic or diabetic range—clear evidence that early awareness can save lives.

This is more than a health campaign—it's a humanitarian effort. By offering free A1C testing, the Red Cross gives donors vital health insights and encourages proactive steps toward better health, especially in communities most affected by diabetes.

Why Everyone Should Pay Attention

Many people are at risk of developing type 2 diabetes and may be unaware of their condition. Factors such as genetics, lifestyle habits and limited access to healthcare contribute to this increased chance.

Diabetes remains a leading cause of kidney failure, lower-limb amputations, and adult blindness—and adults with diabetes face twice the risk of heart disease and stroke compared to those without it.

"The A1C test measures average blood sugar levels over the past three months, providing a clearer and more reliable picture than a standard glucose test," explains Dr. Jorge Ríos, medical director for the American Red Cross. Dr. Ríos knows this firsthand—he discovered he had diabetes through an A1C test, which allowed him to act before serious complications developed.

"Eight years ago, during a medical convention, I came down with what I thought was the flu. I was so exhausted I couldn't even leave my hotel room," recalls Dr. Ríos. "Weeks later, the fatigue continued. My doctor tested my A1C—it was almost 7. The normal range is 5.7% or less. That's when I was diagnosed with diabetes."

Dr. Ríos immediately changed his diet, began exercising, and started medication. Today, his diabetes is well managed—and his message is clear:

"If you have a parent, sibling, or grandparent with diabetes, get tested.



This November, when you donate blood with the Red Cross, you can get a diabetes test at no charge.

And perhaps once a year, ask your doctor to test you if you have symptoms like I did, which was feeling very tired. It's an easy test and can save your life," says Dr. Ríos. "Know your numbers so you can make lifestyle changes," he adds.

Dispelling Common Myths

Misinformation often prevents people from seeking help. Here are some common myths about diabetes—and the truths behind them:

• Myth: Herbs or home remedies can cure diabetes.

Truth: Diabetes needs medical care and ongoing management.

• Myth: Only older people get diabetes. Truth: It can affect anyone, including kids and young adults.

• Myth: If you feel fine, you don't need testing.

Truth: Diabetes can be silent for years; fatigue may be the only sign.

• Myth: Diabetes is a death sentence.

Truth: With treatment and healthy habits, people can live full lives.Myth: People with diabetes can't

donate blood.

Fruth: If well-managed, they can donate

Truth: If well-managed, they can donate safely.

Get Tested During November

To receive your free A1C result, make a successful blood, platelet, or plasma donation and ensure you haven't received an A1C test through the Red Cross in the past 12 months. Results will appear within one to two weeks in the Red Cross Blood Donor App or at Red-CrossBlood.org. If your A1C is elevated, follow up with your healthcare provider.

"This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples." - John 15: 8


Humility







Recipe Korner

A Lovely Lemon Cake For the Holidays

(NAPS)—This holiday season you can add some zest to your dessert table with a delightful lemon cake made with a simple recipe from Ellen Wright's fifth cookbook: *Best of the Best* (full of her best and most favorite recipes and available on Amazon).

The cake is moist and velvety, travels well and is great to bring to a pot-luck dinner. In short, it is a wonderful cake well worth knowing.

Lemon Cake with Lemon Glaze Makes 8 to 10 servings

- 1 package yellow cake mix
- 1 package instant pudding, lemon flavored
- 1/2 cup water
- ¹/₄ cup sweet sherry, port, or orange juice
- 34 cup canola oil
- 1 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 4 large whole eggs

For the glaze:

- 1 cup confectioners sugar
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 1. Preheat oven 350 degrees Fahrenheit.
- 2. Grease and flour a bundt pan. Knock out the excess flour.
- 3. In a large mixing bowl using an electric mixer on medium speed, place the mixes, oil, eggs, and sherry and mix for 5-10 minutes.
- 4. Pour the cake batter into the prepared bundt pan and bake in the middle of the oven for 45 minutes or until the sides of the cake are pulling away from the pan.
- 5. Cool 10 minutes and loosen with a sharp knife until you can unmold the cake easily.

For the lemon glaze:

In a small bowl, add the lemon juice to the confectioner's sugar and mix with a fork until it is smooth. Drizzle the glaze on the cake when it is still warm, but not hot.



A sweet treat at holiday time or anytime is an easy-to-bake (and heavenly to eat) lemon cake.

Ellen's Tips:

She's not above using a shortcut to reach a good result.

- If the cake breaks, take the piece out and place it in its rightful position. When you glaze, it won't show.
- This cake can be made ahead of time. Just make sure to wrap it well in plastic wrap with toothpicks stuck in the top so the glaze won't spoil.

The days before the holidays get here are being checked off more quickly than one can imagine. These few upcoming days over the holidays are the main cooking and gathering events of the year. All I can think about is main courses and side dishes. Who wants what? Do we go heavy on traditional foods or just surprise everyone with something we've never had? Do we stick with conjuring up feelings of nostalgia as we wander down memory lane over turkey and dressing, or shake things up with another meal altogether while opening new avenues of discussion?

Cooking and eating together is a bonding experience. In the past as hunters and gatherers, both men and women hunted and foraged for food. When whales were killed, often an entire tribe would gather to break down the whale into many meals. One person doing this job would likely not be able to get it done before it spoiled. When buffalo were killed, each entire buffalo was utilized to make clothes, tools and provide food. Everyone would feast together and celebrate the life of the buffalo that provided for all needs. Working together helps everyone have enough. Celebrating brings us together.

Our current lifestyles do not support communal eating as much as in the past. We are all in such a hurry to get through each day we often just pick up something quick from a restaurant and eat when we can. Different jobs and work hours make getting together even more difficult. Many of us have forgotten the joys of gathering each night at the supper table with family to share everyone's day and the positive impact of doing so. Work and other demands frequently interfere with this family tradition. Robin Fox, anthropologist, states: "A meal is about civilizing children. It's about teaching them to be a member of their culture." Gathering over the holidays for a good meal or two can give our children and grandchildren an opportunity to be with extended family and bask in the love we share for one another. Please pass the gravy!
